



sliding



■ Slide H: 1.37m

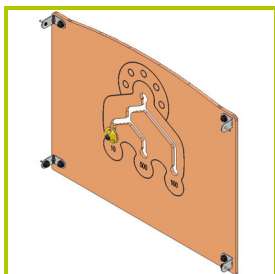
The slide enables users to experience the ever popular pleasure of sliding down to the ground from platforms located at a height of 1.17m or 1.37m. A protective bar at the top of the slide prevents any accidental falls, as well as providing a support for users installing themselves on the slide bed.

handling



■ 'Maze' board

The play panel maze is a handling and dexterity game. Children need to think before understanding how the game works: they must turn the wheel and guide the marble towards the desired path, using the effect of gravity. The aim is to bring it to the center or outside circle of the maze. Patience and dexterity are necessary to overcome the tricks and false paths where the ball can fall.



■ The Pachinko Play Panel

<p>The yellow disc is dropped from the top of the panel and randomly falls down into one of the 3 different values (10,100 and 500) located at the bottom of the panel. The game can be played alone or against other users to see who can score the highest number of points with 3 goes. Not only is it a fun game, but it also provides children with the opportunity to discover the basic principles of gravitational forces.</p>

climbing



■ Curved ladder

The curved shape ergonomic of the stainless steel ladder adds an extra design and play dimension to this platform access. It requires children to use strength and balance to climb the rungs of the ladder, before using their spatial awareness to negotiate the gap between the ladder and the platform.



■ Incline net H: 1.37m

The net is accessed from ground level and provides an access to a platform (1.37m or 1.77m) on the multi-play unit. Balance and coordination is tested by the moving ropes and the curved shape of the element. An additional challenge comes in the form of being able to constantly see the distance to the ground below.

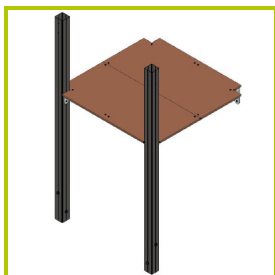
getting across



■ Curved bridge

The curved bridge provides an obstacle free passage between two platforms. The curved shape of the element gives it not only design appeal, but also adds play value and reduces the safer surfacing requirements. The sides of the bridge feature both a stainless steel handrail for reassurance and a net structure that children can look through to observe the rest of the playground.

meeting / role play



■ Square platform

The size of the square platform (1.2m x 1.2m) means that it can cater for a large number of users at any one time. Up to 4 separate play elements can be connected to the square tower. The platform is manufactured from non-slip HPL, providing users with additional grip under foot.

1.37m: height for younger users looking to learn and develop climbing and balancing techniques.

1.77m: height for users in search of intermediate to advanced play challenges.

hiding / resting



■ Play table

The table fits under the platform providing either shade or shelter according to the weather conditions, and optimizing the available space. The table and two benches accommodate up to 4 users at any one time and encourage interaction. At the heart of the table a game allows users to invent stories around a series of different destinations that are found on the moving play panel.
