



climbing



Slope

This access to the 60cm platform is an ideal element for the youngest users to practice their climbing skills on. The rounded, polypropylene holds are designed for users to place their feet on and push upwards, whilst a horizontal bar allows users to pull themselves up. Transferring from the ramp to the platform tests children's spatial awareness as they need to pass under the horizontal bar and between the two side panels.



Climbing wall

The climbing wall provides an alternative route to the 1.17m platform. The button climbing holds are user-friendly supports for children's hands and feet as they make their way up and across the climbing wall. The anti-slip surface of the climbing wall provides additional grip. Different coloured climbing holds give a decorative appeal, as well as allowing other users to be able to offer advice as to the best hold on which to place a hand or foot in order to advance upwards. Accompanying adults can help the users to improve their technique by advising them to push with their legs, whilst using their hands to direct their bodies across the wall surface.

sliding



Slide

The slide enables users to experience sliding down to the ground from platforms located at a height of 1.17m. A protective bar at the top of the slide prevents any accidental falls, as well as providing a support for users as they install themselves on the slide bed. The relatively steep gradient at the start of the slide provides exhilarating sensations, before slowing down users as they come towards the safety surfacing.

The mask seat-ledge is attached under the slide. This configuration optimises play space. It is an area for resting or quiet play, alone or in a group. The mask enables quiet observation or interaction between the child hiding and the other who enjoys seeing real eyes on the other side!

Slide

The slide enables users to experience the ever popular pleasure of sliding down to the ground from platforms located at a height of 0.60m. A protective bar at the top of the slide prevents any accidental falls, as well as providing a support for users installing themselves on the stainless steel slide bed.

handling



Maze panel

This panel is a touch and visual game activity needing observation and thinking. The child has to find the lion's print among several options. He/she may find it by knowledge, following the paths of the maze visually or by touching the panel.

climbing



Climbing net

Nearly all children love climbing on nets and in this case alternative rope challenges are available for the different ability levels. For younger users the net can be easily accessed from both ground level or via the step formed by the especially designed stainless steel frame. More advanced users may wish to climb to the top of the net at 2m high and negotiate a route over to the other side of the net, before accessing one of the platforms.



Stairway

This stairway provides easy and safe access to the platform 60cm above ground. Children are protected by full fencing which they can hold on to. Two handles also enable them to hold themselves in position easily for climbing up or down. The metal steps are equipped with an anti-slip, textured finish providing grip even in wet conditions. Two play activities are accessible from the ground, on the sides of the stairway: One letter recognition touch and visual play activity and a "hide/show the marmoset" game in which the user must raise the marmoset to see it. These features optimise the play space and develop children's imagination.

getting across



Intermediate staircase

The intermediate staircase provides an inclined access from the 60cm platform to the 1.17m platform. The stairway is wide enough to allow users to pass, whilst narrow enough to provide reassurance for younger users climbing up for the first time. The metal steps are equipped with an anti-slip, textured finish providing grip even in wet conditions. The stairway is decorated with two play activities: the mask, an interactive activity, is ideal for taking photos, and the chameleon, the tail of which is spiral-shaped and creates an optical effect when turned.



■ **Themed square platform**

This compact platform located at only 60cm above the ground provides reassurance for the youngest users. Parents can hold the hand of children using play equipment for the first time. The solid materials used in the construction of the platform ? non-slip HPL and stainless steel ? ensure stability and long term durability.



■ **Themed tower**

This compact, rectangular platform (0.90 x 0.60m) is a place for stopping, resting and combining the various play activities. The compact roofing adds to the theme of nature and adventure, with a toucan taking off in the greenery. They also provide protection from rain and sun. The platform is an anti-slip compact panel.
